An Act in Relation to the Letters of Sailors and Marines in the Service of the **United States**

January 21, 1862. CHAP. IX. — An Act in Relation to the Letters of Sailors and Marines in the Service of the United States.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United Letters sent by States of America in Congress assembled, That the provisions of the act sauors and marines need not be of July twenty-second, eighteen hundred and sixty-one, authorizing soldiers to send letters through the mails of the United States without preprepaid.
