The Hanging Davis Designs

The Confederacy produced only one hanging Lincoln cover according to the CSA Catalog. It is listed under the Confederate Censuses. The Union prepared several different hanging Davis patriotic covers of different varieties, some in different colors and with different inscriptions.

This census includes only postally used covers that include a caricature identified as Jefferson Davis hanging. Some covers include a figure hanging but not identified as Jefferson Davis. These are not included.

Descriptions of covers pictured in black and white do not always identify the color or colors of the imprint. In those cases, the color is assumed, and this is noted in the census description.

The designs are categorized by a two-character identifier. The first character identifies the major type (see table below). The second identifies the subtype. The third and fourth characters identify different colors and inscriptions. All types are listed and described in the “Count” table on the next page.

Notes

The Transition Period

It is not unusual to see the old series of US stamps used on hanging Davis covers. This was the result of the demonetization of the old stamps by the US Post Office Department. This involved the preparation of new stamps and then the distribution of the stamps. This process began in August 1861 with the first new stamps being sent to post offices in larger towns. The process went on into early 1862 in western states. This transition period saw the use of old (1851 through 1860) stamps on mail in the north before new stamps were available.

Once a post office received the new stamps there was a six-day exchange period (old for new stamps) and then the old stamps were no longer valid at that post office.

Authentic Hanging Davis Cover?

The cover below has a hanging Davis imprint. However, the postal use is questionable. It bears a US 3c 1857 stamp tied by what appears to be a Virginia town postmark dated 2 August addressed to Thompson, Georgia.

If postally used why was the stamp not challenged by Confederate postmasters. Was the stamp added to the cover?
