Alum Springs Stampless Markings (not to scale)

The different markings are identified by the 2012 *Confederate States of American* (CSA) *Catalog and Handbook* Stampless Type. The letters "X, Y, and Z," are used to designate added items not in the CSA Catalog. The absence of a CSA Catalog Type in the illustrations above indicates that item is not included in the census.

Items are presented in the census in the order of the illustrations above.

This census is based on images of covers. Only covers for which an image was obtained are listed in the census. For this reason, this census may be far from complete.

NOTE: Every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of the census, but the inclusion of an item is not a guarantee of authenticity.

Envelopes with Printed Box for Postmaster's Free Frank

There are at least two different types of the free frank box. One as a thin two-line border (two black and white illustrations below). The other also has a two-line border, but the outer line is very thick (see color illustration below).

There are several recorded examples of envelopes with a printed box for the postmaster's free frank. Curiously, none bear postmarks. All are illustrated below.
