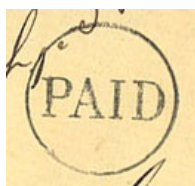

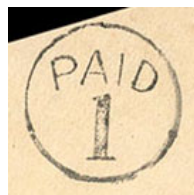

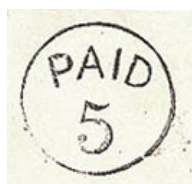

Note: All uses of the Type D and E markings dated in June are assumed to be 1861, if the postmark is not year dated.

The different markings are identified by the 2012 *Confederate States of American (CSA) Catalog and Handbook* Stampless Type. The letters “X, Y, and Z,” are used to designate added items not in the CSA Catalog. The absence of a CSA Catalog Type in the illustrations above indicates that item is not included in the census.

Items are presented in the census in the order of the illustrations above.

This census is based on images of covers. Only covers for which an image was obtained are listed in the census. For this reason, this census may be far from complete.

NOTICE: Some of the stampless markings were also used on provisional covers. The difference is the presence of a control in the form of a postmark on the reverse of provisional covers.

NOTE: Every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of the census, but the inclusion of an item is not a guarantee of authenticity.
