Marshall Stampless Markings (not to scale)

The different markings are identified by the 2012 *Confederate States of American (CSA) Catalog and Handbook* Stampless Type. The letters "X, Y, and Z," are used to designate added items not in the CSA Catalog. The absence of a CSA Catalog Type in the illustrations above indicates that item is not included in the census.

Items are presented in the census in the order of the illustrations above.

This census is based on images of covers. Only covers for which an image was obtained are listed in the census. For this reason, this census may be far from complete.

NOTE: Every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of the census, but the inclusion of an item is not a guarantee of authenticity.

Legacy Marking

The 2012 CSA Catalog includes as a legacy listing a Type A marking without a rate (see illustration below). An example of this marking was not found in the preparation of this census.

The PAID + 10 Type B and C Markings

The 2012 CSA Catalog describes the difference between the two markings as the width of the "0" in "10." When preparing this census one example of the wide "0" was found but other differences were found which questions two different types.



The two left images above are listed as Type B in this census. Note they both have a narrower "0" than the Type C on the left. But if you look further you will note the left example, and the right example have a common characteristic the colorless spot in the left side of the "0." There is another difference. The left example and the right example do not have the same "1." Note the stem of the "1" on the center example meets the serif at a right angle. In the two outside examples the stem of the "1" meets the serif with a bracket. A bracket is defined as a curved or angled stroke that connects the serif or terminal of a letter to its stem.



This census will not attempt to resolve the classifications of the Type B and C markings.
